### **Import of animal by-products/processed products for research, diagnostic and education purposes**

The Swedish Board of Agriculture on the 5<sup>th</sup> of February 2025 granted an import permit for Statens veterinärmedicinska anstalt (National veterinary institute) to import animal by-products/processed products (category 1, 2 and 3) for research, diagnostic and education purposes (see enclosed document with diarienummer 6.7.18-20086/2024). The research samples are covered by the European Parliament and Council Regulation (EC) No 1069/2009 of 21 October 2009 on health rules concerning animal by-products and derived products are not intended for human consumption and repealing Regulation (EC) No 1774/2002 (Regulation on animal by-products), and therefore require an import permit.

Condition for the permit to import are:

the samples are sent directly to Statens veterinärmedicinska anstalt, Uppsala (registration number for research, diagnostic and education purposes: SE3800634211), the products are used for research, diagnostic and education use, and that the handling of the product is carried out in a way that is safe from an animal health aspect.

The import permit is valid until the 5<sup>th</sup> of February 2027.
